## **Study Suggestions**

- READ THE CHAPTER. Instructors do not lecture on all of the topics in the textbook.
- Review class notes and all homework brief exercises, exercises and problems.
- Review the materials at the end of each chapter:
  - Learning Objective Review
  - Glossary Review (vocabulary)
  - o Practice Multiple Choice Questions, Practice Exercises and Practice Problem
- Work the questions, brief exercises, exercises and problems that were not assigned for each chapter. The instructor and the Tutoring Center have answers for all of them.
- Review the resource materials and practice quizzes and exams available on the textbook website.
- Form a study group and use it to share knowledge and teach other.
- If the class has an SI leader: go to the SI review sessions, ask questions and get answers, try to answer the questions other students ask and listen to the answers they get.
- Visit the Harper College Tutoring Center and make a new friend who knows financial accounting
- Work through the chapter and exam reviews packets online at the Tutoring center's website. Remember that these packets try to cover all of the major topics in the chapters, not only the topics on the exams.
- The departmental exams do not cover all the topics in the chapters. Study all the topics, but focus on the topics the instructor emphasized, highlighted or spent a lot of time on.
