Part 1- ADMISSION

University Admissions Requirements

National Louis University (NLU) offers students who complete an Associate in Applied Science at Harper College (HC) the opportunity to complete the Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice with full recognition of the Associate degree earned. All required courses in the Associate's degree completed with a grade of C or better will apply to the Bachelor's degree. Students who do not complete the Associate's degree will be admitted to NLU as standard transfer students and will have all previous college work evaluated and transferred on a course-by-course basis.

Program Admissions Requirements

Students who successfully complete the HC Associate in Applied Science degree in Law Enforcement and Justice Administration with the minimum GPA of 2.0 will be guaranteed admission to National Louis University and the Criminal Justice degree program.

Part 2- ASSESSMENT

The COMPASS math and writing assessments must be completed by the end of the first term of enrollment at NLU. Students who have taken the COMPASS assessments at another institution within the past two years may forward that score to NLU in lieu of this requirement.

A total of 180 QH is required for completion of the BA Criminal Justice degree at National Louis. It will be the student's responsibility to complete all coursework required to meet this total beyond the HC Associate in Applied Science and NLU's BA Criminal Justice program in order to meet the degree requirements. Each student will work with their NLU Academic Advisor to ensure degree completion and the fulfillment of all specific Criminal Justice degree requirements.

Part 6- 3+1 OPTION

Students who wish to complete three years with Harper College before transferring to National Louis University may do so by completing the two year Associate of Applied Science in Law Enforcement and Justice Administration program and then completing the additional coursework below to fulfill remaining general education coursework. A student who completes all of these requirements at Harper College would have 65 Quarter Hours of coursework remaining at NLU upon transfer. The last 12 hours (3 courses) must be taken at NLU.
