

**Harper College – Associate of Applied Science – Graphic Design
to Robert Morris College – Bachelor of Applied Science in Graphic Design**

Students completing the Graphic Design program at Harper College and receiving their Associate in Applied Science Degree are eligible to enroll in the Graphic Design Program at Robert Morris College to complete their Bachelor of Applied Science in Graphic Design Degree. Students will make a smooth transition with all credits from the Associate of Applied Science Degree being accepted in their entirety.

In addition to the Graphic Design AAS degree requirements at Harper College, the following courses are recommended for transfer:

- ❖ Creative Design Track students should complete ART 110 – Drawing 1
- ❖ Technical Track students should complete ART 110 – Drawing 1 and GRA 120 – Graphic Design 1

Students completing both the AAS degree requirements AND the recommended additional coursework can complete their bachelors degree at Robert Morris College in as little as 15 months.
