

Illinois Temporary Visitor Driver's License

The Process for F-1 Students

Valid for driving only. Not valid for identification

Step One

□ Verify with the International Student Coordinator that your SEVIS record is active. You can call or email Jill Izumikawa: 847.925.6756, jizumika@harpercollege.edu

Step Two – ONLY if you are age 18 to 20 years old

- You must complete an online driver education course *prior* to obtaining your license.
 - Go to <u>http://www.ilsos.gov/adultdrivered/providerlist</u> to find an Illinois-certified school for your six-hour online driving course
 - \circ Once you complete this course, you may proceed to Step Three

Step Three

- Take the following items to the Chicago West Driver's License Facility located at 5301 W. Lexington Avenue, Chicago, 60644
 (See office schedule www.cyberdriveillinois.com)
 - Your passport
 - Your Form I-94, available online at <u>www.cbp.gov/I94</u>
 - Your current Form I-20
 - Two items of proof of your address in Illinois such as electric bill, water bill, or your lease/rental agreement with your name on it.

For a Temporary Visitor Driver's License, you may only go to the Chicago listed facility above or the facility in Rockford, west of Palatine.

You will take a written test and a driving test. You will pay approximately \$30.
