Valid for driving only. Not valid for identification

The Process for F-1 Students

Step One

Request a verification letter from the International Student Coordinator.
You can email Jill Izumikawa at jizumika@harpercollege.edu

Ask Jill Izumikawa if your SEVIS record is active

Step Two

- Take the following items to the nearest Social Security Office:
 - O Verification letter from Jill Izumikawa
 - Your passport
 - Your Form I-94, available online at www.cbp.gov/I94
 - Your current Form I-20

You can find the nearest Social Security Office at the following link on the web: www.ssa.gov Use the Office Locator feature and enter your zip code.

Request written verification from the Social Security Office that you are **NOT** eligible for a social security number. They will give you a letter.

Step Three

- Take the following items to the Chicago West Driver's License Facility located at 5301 W. Lexington Avenue, Chicago, 60644 (See schedule on website)
 - Verification form from the Social Security Office
 - Your passport
 - Your Form I-94, available online at www.cbp.gov/I94
 - Your current Form I-20
 - Proof of your address in Illinois such as electric bill, water bill, or your lease/rental agreement with your name on it.

For a Temporary Visitor Driver's License, you may only go to this facility or in Rockford.

You will take a written test and a driving test. You will pay approximately \$30. For complete details of the Temporary Visitor Driver's License (TVDL), you may visit the following website:
