RESUME SUMMARY STATEMENT CHECKLIST

A summary statement, also known as a professional summary or resume summary, is a short introduction at the beginning of your resume that describes your top selling points and what you can do for the employer. It highlights your experience, skills, and accomplishments.

Create a statement that catches the employer's interest to read the rest of your resume and contact you for an interview! Summary statements are used by recent college grads, career changers, and experienced professionals.

Consider the following in writing your summary:

- ✓ Complete your resume first and use it as a guide to what to include in your summary statement.
- ✓ Limit the length of summary to 3-4 lines to ensure it gets read. Large blocks of text are often passed over in a review of a resume.
- ✓ Do not use personal pronouns No "I", "Me", or "My".
- ✓ Include academic accomplishments and leadership experience.
- ✓ Add professional interests and passions significant to position.
- ✓ Integrate technical and non-technical skills.
- ✓ Incorporate keywords from the listing in your resume summary. This will help the employer see how you are a good fit for the job.
- ✓ Make sure to proofread carefully to avoid spelling and grammar errors.
