



Applicant Checklist

Submit **all** the following items to be considered for admission to Harper College

ALL International Student Applicants

- HARPER COLLEGE APPLICATION — Complete the online application form, www.harpercollege.edu, select the “International Student” option.
- APPLICATION FEE — pay the \$25.00, non-refundable, application fee along with the online application form.
- INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMINISTRATIVE FEE — pay the \$150.00, non-refundable fee through the international student website.
- SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION FORM — Complete both pages of this form. If you are not supporting yourself financially, be sure to have your sponsor sign page two of this form.
- BANK VERIFICATION — You must attach a bank certification or letter verifying that you and/or your sponsor has at least U.S.\$23,000 available to provide for your first academic year (two semesters) of tuition, fees, and living expenses. You can have more than one sponsor and they can be in the U.S. or a different country.
- PHOTOGRAPH — Include a recent, passport-sized photo
- HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION — Submit proof of completion of high school (secondary education). Your diploma or certificate of general education must be translated into English.
- PASSPORT — Submit a copy of the identification page of your passport.

English Proficiency Requirement

- LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY — Students must submit proof of minimum English language ability for ESL studies or proficiency for college-level courses.

ESL Applicants

TOEFL iBT Score between 28 and 78

IELTS Score between 3.5 and 6.0

College Level Applicants

- TOEFL iBT score of 79 or higher
- IELTS score of 6.5 or higher
- Passed English 101 at a U.S. college or university

Applicants with Dependent Spouse and/or Children

- BANK VERIFICATION — Your bank certificate or letter must show proof of additional \$3,000 for each dependent.
- PASSPORT — Submit a copy of each dependent's identification page from the passport

Transfer Students (already in the U.S.)

- Transcript from your current U.S. school
- Printed copy of your Form I-94. You can access the electronic record from www.cbp.gov/i94. Click on the link, “Get I-94 Number Now”.
- Copies of previously issued Forms I-20
