Transferring to Academy of Art University

- All courses must be a minimum of 3 units to transfer to Academy of Art University. Courses with less than 3 units may be combined to make 3 units if taken under the same class name with progressive levels.
- Coursework presented for transfer must be successfully completed with a letter grade of "C" or above or a grade of "Pass" in a Pass/Fail course.
- AP and test scores may be used to place out of a Liberal Arts course, but the units must be made up with a Liberal Arts Elective. Visit Academy of Art University's Liberal Arts Placement web page for details on applicable placement scores.
- For more transfer details and to apply visit Academy of Art University's webpage for transfer students.
- Student choice elective 1, 2, and 3 in addition to the other categories will provide additional experience with either general education
 or skills and knowledge related to the major or the arts. Sample transfer courses may be drawing, painting, photography, music,
 theater, etc. so long as they are at least 3 units.
