<sup>7</sup>40 upper division hours are required for graduation. This can be met through general education, portfolio, or a combination.

<sup>8</sup>All Courses listed for EIU can be taken online. Some courses are offered online and in the Chicago-land area (Triton, Grayslake).

<sup>9</sup>The courses (ENG102 & MAT requirement) are not currently offered in Fast Track (although they would be on the main campus). These courses are additional requirements for Fast Track Business Administration AAS students interested in completing a B.S in Organizational and Professional Development.

Note - OPD majors are exempt from the foreign language requirement at Eastern.
