3. Students may transfer in 66 Lower Division semester hours from a community college.

4. A maximum of eight semester hours of physical education activity courses may be transferred.

5. A maximum of eight semester hours of applied music and/or theatre may be transferred.

6. To be admitted in good standing the student's cumulative GPA must be a 2.00 or higher.

7. Grades below C- will not transfer.
